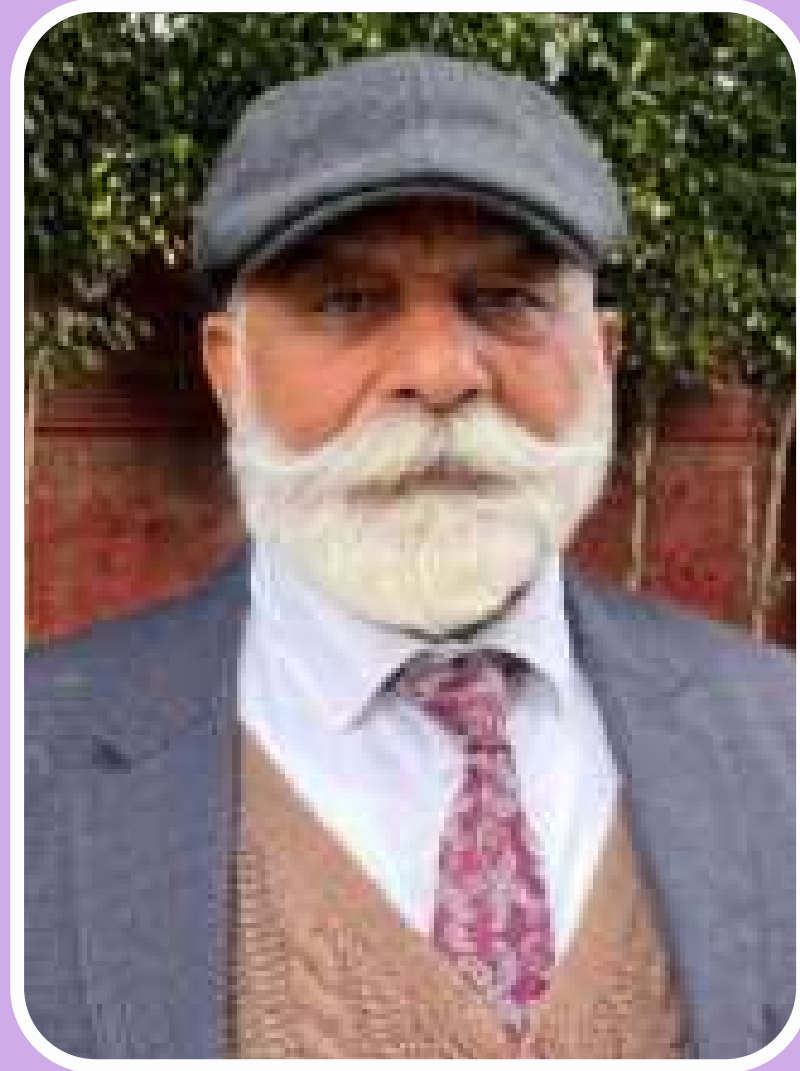

“A nation's culture resides in the hearts and in the soul of its people.”

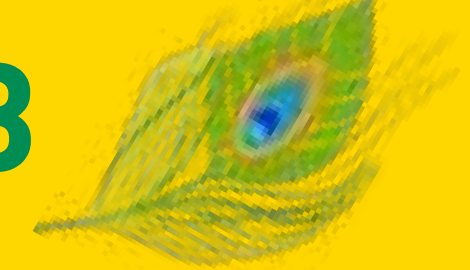

JANMASHTAMI CELEBRATION 06.09.23



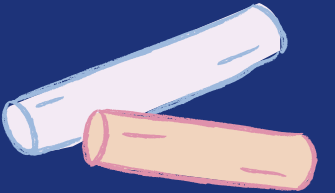

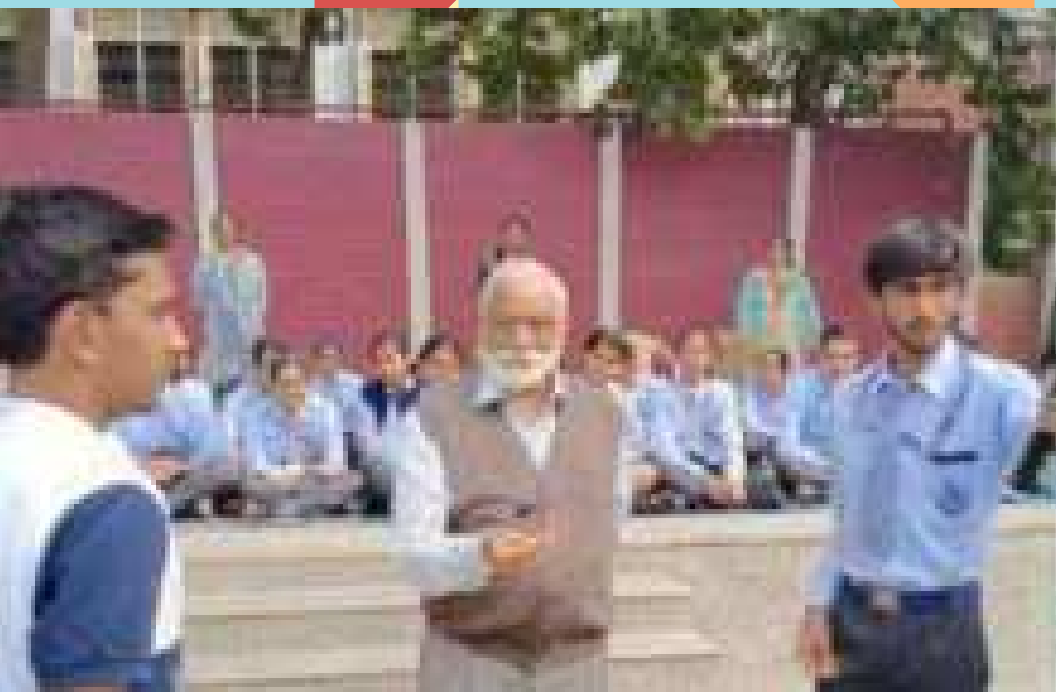


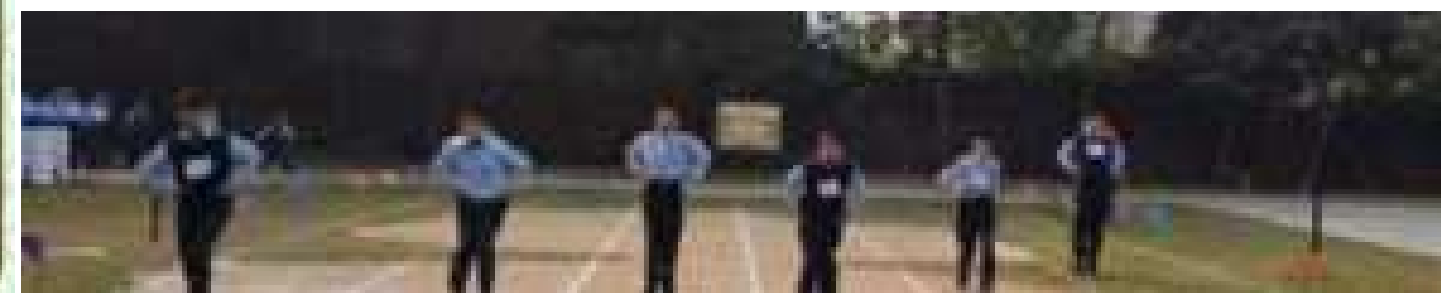
SPORTS WEEK

BHARATIYA BHASHA UTSAV 28.09.23 TO 11.12.23

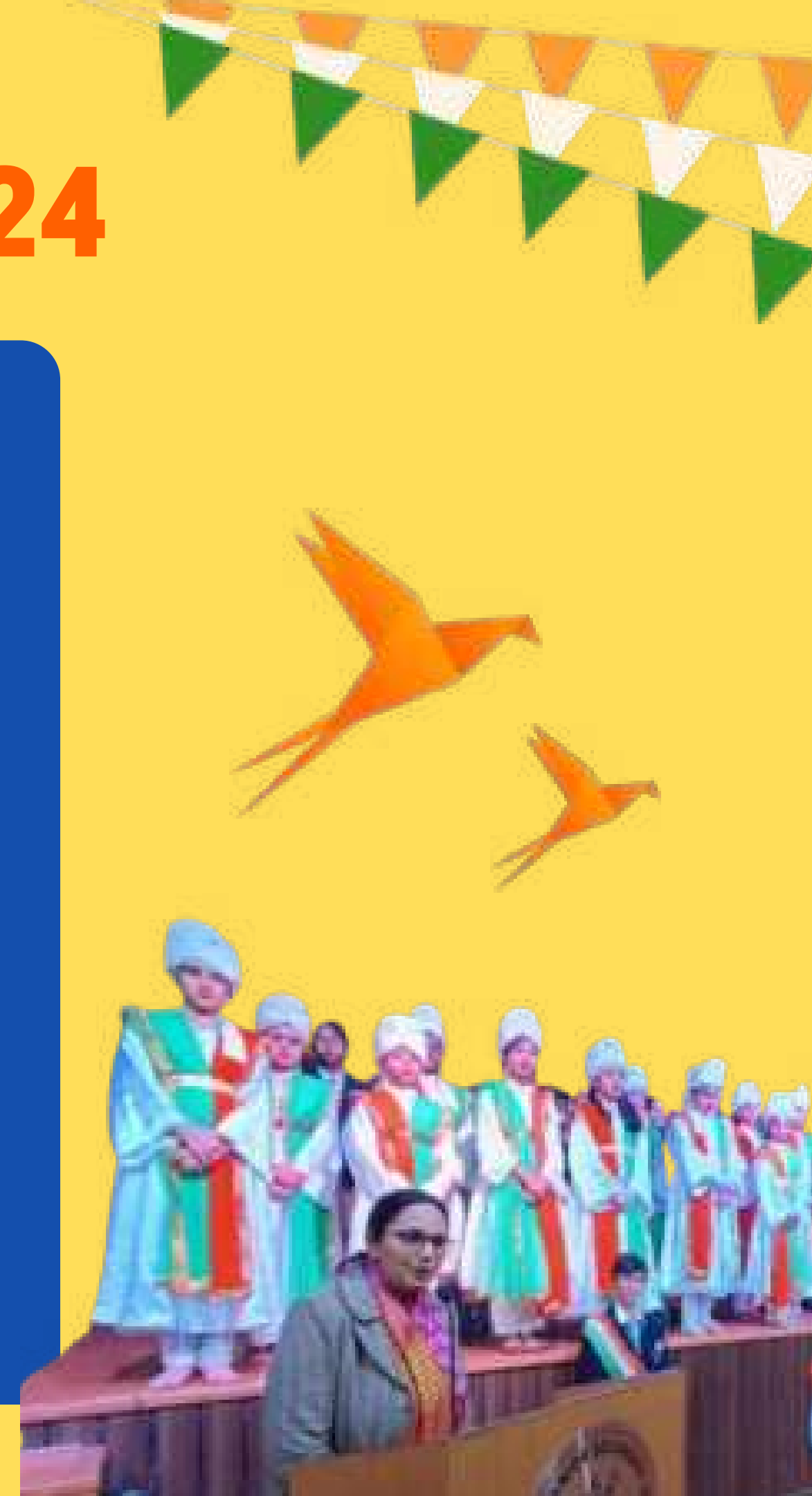

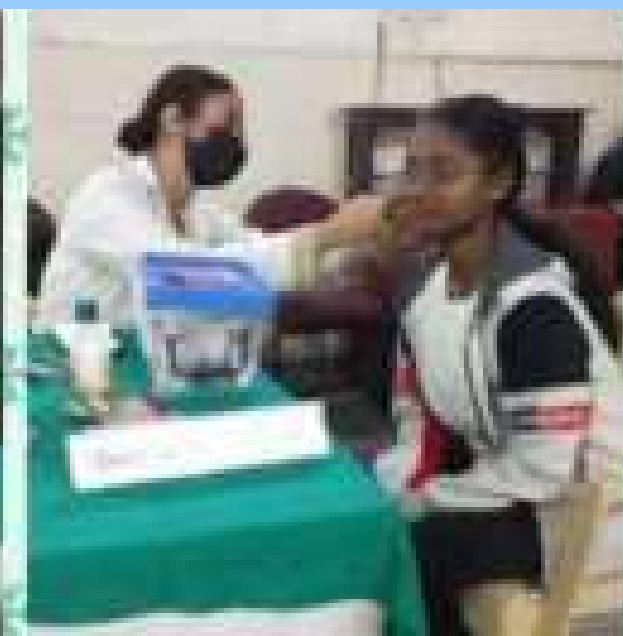


HEALTH CHECKUP

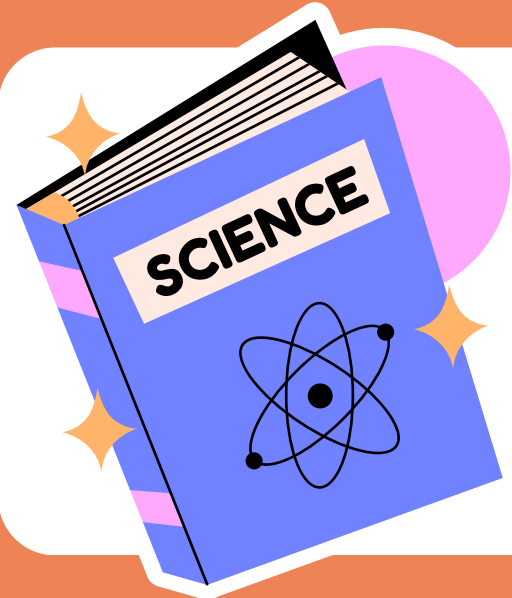


FELICITATING MERITORIOUS STUDENTS AND TEACHERS

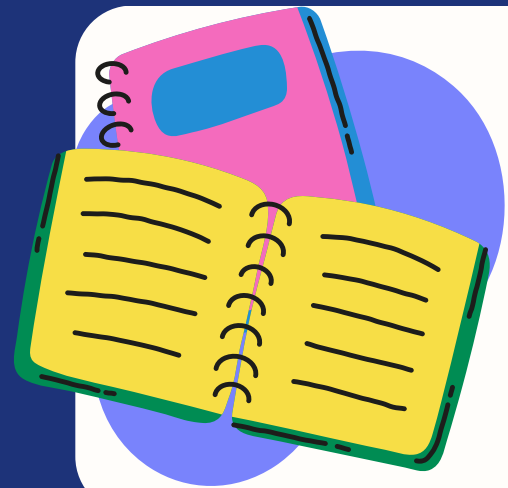




ROAD SAFETY CONVENTION 15.01.24, 16.01.24 & 17.01.24

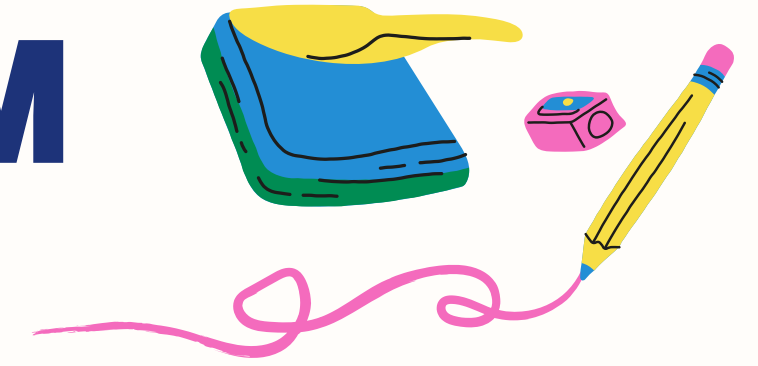

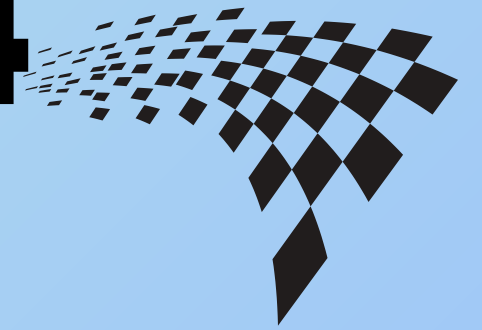
