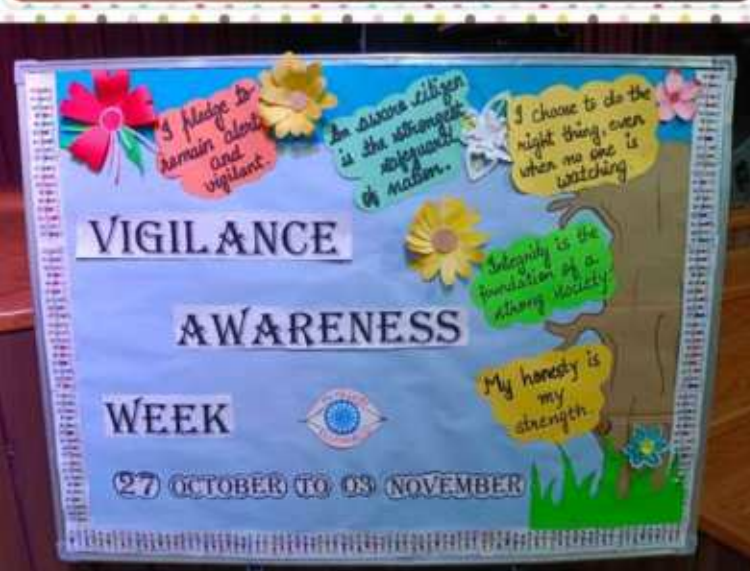

In his address, the School Chairman appreciated the students' spirit, encouraged them to embrace challenges, and highlighted the importance of balancing academics with sports for holistic growth.







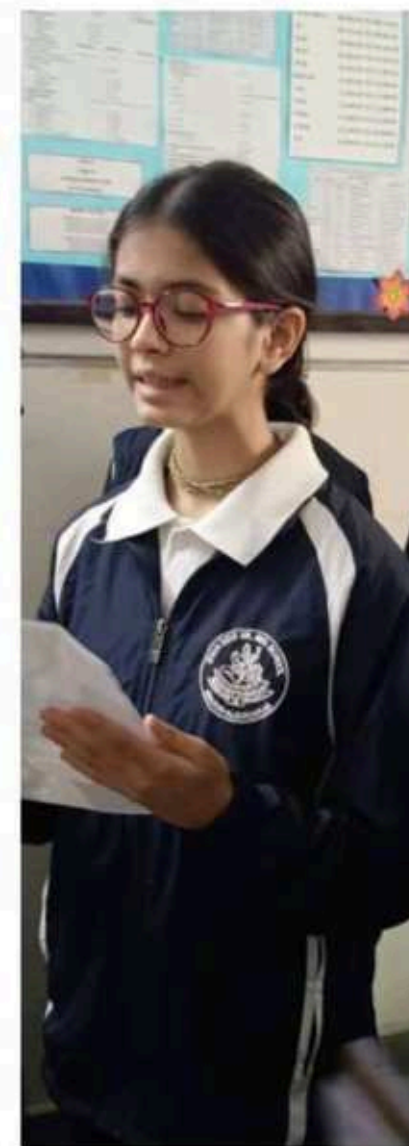
# Human Rights Day

## 24<sup>th</sup> January 2026



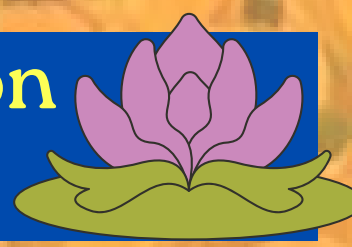

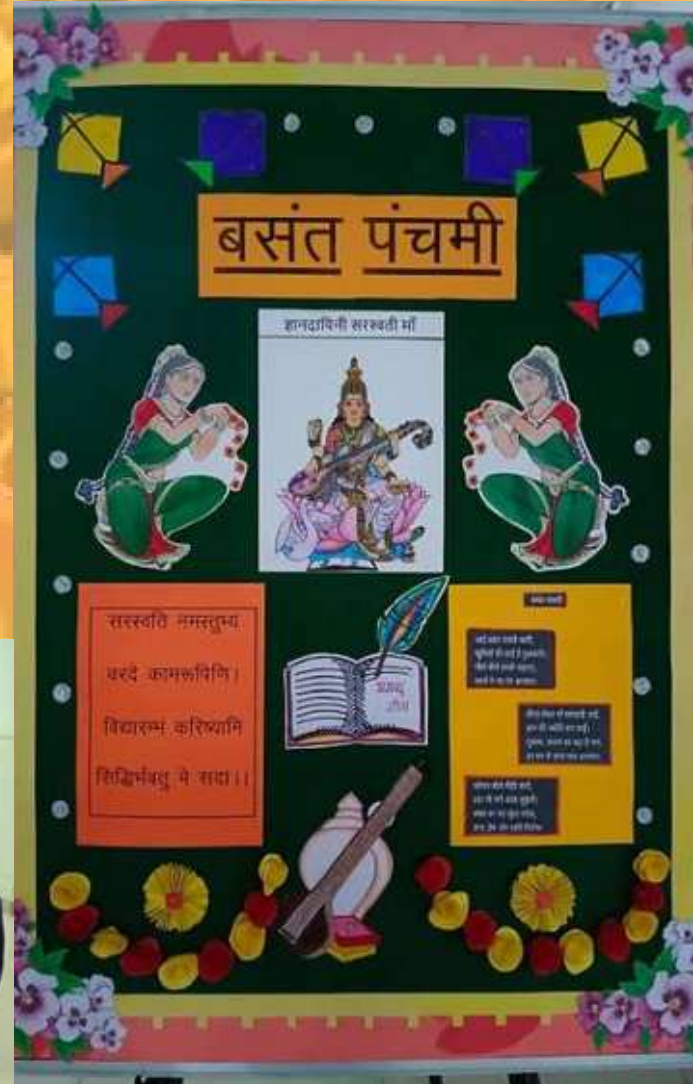


# Vasant Panchami Celebration

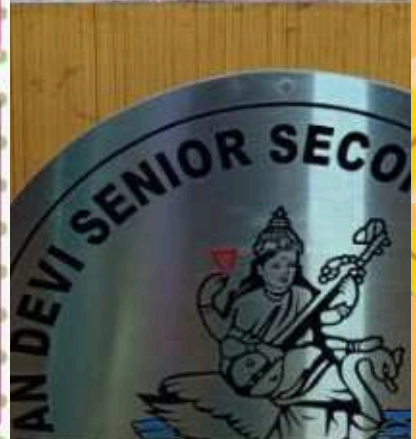

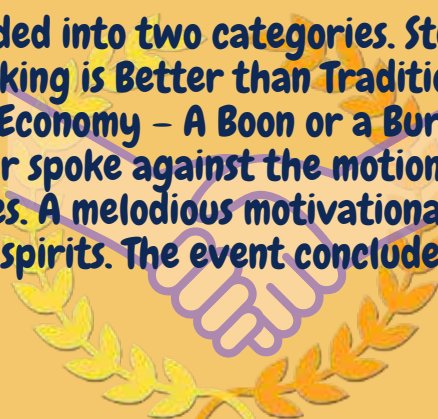
# English Debate Competition
