CROSS COUNTRY RUN (25.11.2023)



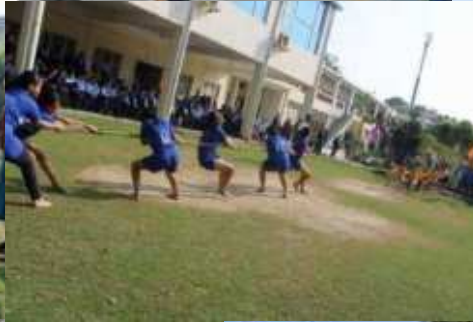

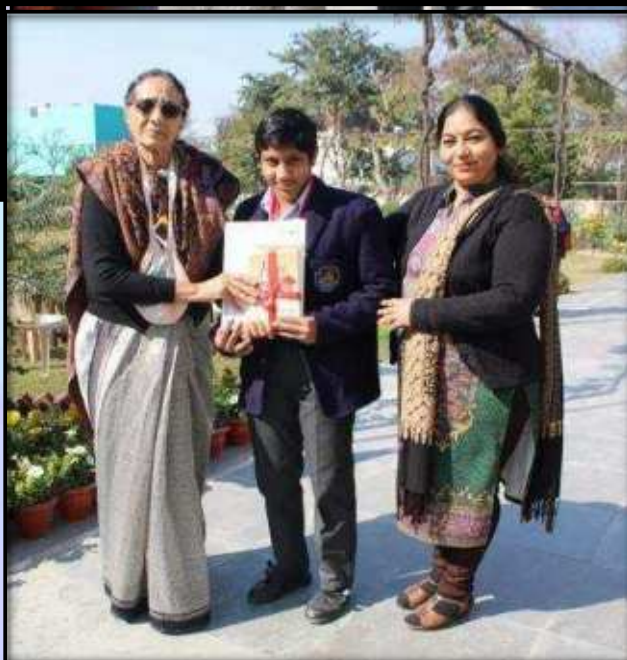
कुश्ती में निकिता ने नैशनल में बनाई जगह

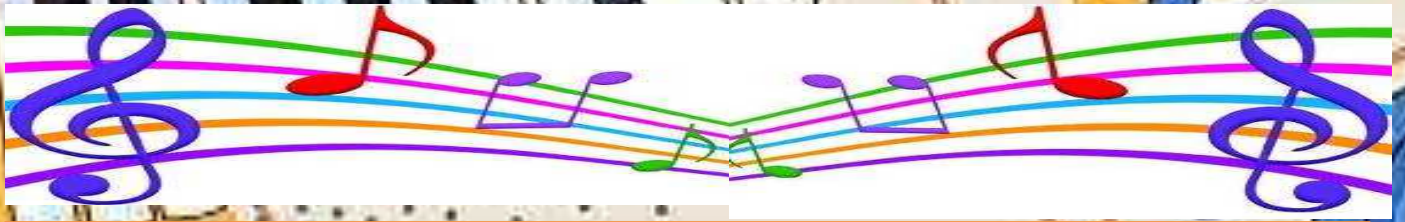
NUKKAD NAATAK - 'MILLET AAHAAR' 4.11.2023
