
Self-discipline is the capacity to regulate one's behaviour, manage time effectively and stay focused on tasks.


INVESTITURE CEREMONY

YOGA DAY CELEBRATION




INDEPENDENCE DAY






SHAKTI SWAROOPA MAA DURGA - A Spiritual Journey
